

Daily News Briefing - June 8, 2026

Executive Summary

- **Philippines Earthquake:** A powerful 7.8-magnitude earthquake struck the southern Philippines, triggering tsunami warnings and leaving at least 19 dead.
- **Market Turmoil:** South Korean stocks crashed nearly 10% in a "Black Monday" event, while global tech stocks faced pressure from AI selloffs and rising oil prices.
- **Middle East Escalation:** Israel launched missile strikes on Iranian military targets despite diplomatic pleas, causing oil prices to jump and imperiling peace talks.
- **Asia Geopolitics:** Chinese President Xi Jinping visited North Korea amidst reports that 2,300 North Korean soldiers have died fighting alongside Russian forces in Ukraine.
- **AI Impact:** Artificial intelligence was attributed to 40% of US job losses in May, signaling a significant shift in the labor market.

At least 19 dead after major earthquake strikes southern Philippines A powerful 7.8-magnitude earthquake struck off the coast of Sarangani province in Mindanao, triggering tsunami warnings and causing widespread building collapses. The disaster highlights the region's vulnerability along the Pacific Ring of Fire, with residents in nearby provinces advised to evacuate due to the risk of waves exceeding one meter. Korea "Black Monday": Kospi Halts After Crashing Almost 10% South Korean stocks crashed 8.8% in early trading, wiping out nearly 17% of their value since recent peaks and triggering a trading halt. The downturn is largely attributed to semiconductor giants Samsung and SK Hynix, highlighting concerns over overheating in the AI rally and market structure vulnerabilities.
