Executive Summary

- **US-Iran Conflict Escalates:** Following the downing of a US helicopter by an Iranian drone, the US has launched strikes on Iran and intercepted oil tankers in the Gulf of Oman, prompting threats of further action from President Trump.
- **Tech & AI Shifts:** SpaceX is preparing for a major IPO driven by hard-tech moonshots, while AI leaders warn of significant job displacement and security threats from foreign influence operations.
- **Economic & Political Moves:** The UK Chancellor hinted at tax hikes to fund defense, solar energy surpassed coal in the US power mix for the first time, and Romanian government negotiations remain deadlocked.

US Launches Strikes on Iran Following Helicopter Downing Tensions have spiked after a cheap Iranian drone allegedly downed a \$25 million US Army helicopter, prompting US strikes on Iranian targets. President Trump confirmed a "secret military mission" allowed ships to cross Hormuz while the US Army attacked a petrolier near Oman attempting to break the blockade. Mystery Car Bombing Near Moscow Kills Top General A high-ranking Russian military officer was killed in a car bomb explosion in a Moscow suburb, marking the fourth such assassination since the Ukraine war began. Pentagon Blacklists Alibaba, BYD, and Baidu The US Pentagon has added Chinese tech giants Alibaba, BYD, and Baidu to its blacklist of companies supplying technology to the Chinese military.
