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Trump Announces US Investigation into EU Over Google Fine

President Trump has officially announced a new investigation into the European Union following recent fines imposed on Google. The administration argues that the United States should not serve as a financial resource for Europe through such penalties. A Section 301 probe has been launched to examine the fairness of these tech regulations. Trump stated clearly that the US is not Europe's piggy bank during the announcement. Substantial tariffs are being threatened as a potential consequence of the findings. This move signals a significant shift in transatlantic trade relations under the new administration. European officials have expressed concern over the potential economic impact of these tariffs. Tech giants are caught in the middle of this growing diplomatic dispute. Zelensky Says Ukrainian Drones Will Soon Hit Kamchatka and Sakhalin

Army Finds Drone Debris in Romania After F-16 Intercept

Wildfires Force Mass Evacuations Across Europe and NASA Facility
