Romania Declares Heatwave Emergency Amid Red Code Warnings

Romanian authorities have activated emergency plans as a severe heatwave brings temperatures up to 40°C, prompting the Health Ministry to request additional ambulance crews. The National Meteorological Service warned of extreme phenomena including violent storms following three days of intense heat.
